Main purpose of role:

To act as a champion of The Renewal Trust. You will be a proactive and key member of the volunteering team, enabling participation and engagement in our Feel-Good Live Well Dementia Support Programme. You will help create a warm, inclusive environment where participants feel valued and supported, and to assist with delivering activities that promote wellbeing, confidence, and social connection.

Principal accountabilities:

- To support participants living with dementia and their carers during weekly sessions, helping create a safe, welcoming, and inclusive environment.
- To assist with setting up and tidying away activities and refreshments before and after sessions.
- To offer practical help during sessions, such as serving drinks, joining in activities, and providing a listening ear to participants.
- To encourage participation in activities that promote wellbeing, confidence, and social connection.
- To work in a safe, environmentally sustainable, and inclusive manner whilst executing volunteering activities.
- To advocate and be an ambassador for The Renewal Trust and the communities of St Ann's and Sneinton at all times.
- Work closely and collaboratively with other volunteers, to improve volunteer experience and community engagement
- Any other duties deemed appropriate by your Manager

Other responsibilities:

Act as an ambassador for The Renewal Trust at all times, actively promoting its values, aims and services within the local community, especially with regards to equal opportunities and safeguarding adults, young people and children.

Adhere to all company policies, as relevant to the role, and attend meetings and training as directed by your line manager in order to keep your knowledge and skills current to your role
