What we do

Feel Good - a programme of community engagement and recovery for all ages. Throughout the year we offer a whole range of activities and opportunities that are low cost or free and an alternative approach to the cost of living crisis, addressing isolation and loneliness and providing stability and continuity for communities and families.

Feel Good activities and events – we offer a year-round calendar of free and low cost activities for all ages – including Feel Good Festivals throughout the year, ice skating and

Feel Good Gold - Our weekly Feel Good Gold sessions provide people aged 60 and over with a warm space, hot food and fun activities, with travel to and from sessions and access to additional support services from local and national partners.

Feel Good Welcome – offers free support for Refugees and Asylum Seekers in the area, including help with household and personal hygiene items, internet access, and free Mini Movers and family Lego sessions.

Feel Good Community – offers free support to individuals and families who are struggling with the cost of living, including help with household and personal hygiene items, internet access and seasonal support at Christmas, summer and the start of the school year

Feel Good Breakfast – throughout the school holidays anyone can drop in for a free breakfast – no questions asked. Breakfast includes cereals, toast, fruit, hot and cold drinks

Holiday programme – events and activities during the school holidays, including Lego Lunch Club – a drop off Lego session with a hot lunch and Lego Make and Take, a family Lego building event with Lego sets that attendees can take home.

Mini Movers - is a programme of weekly play sessions for ages 0 to 4, supported by BBC Children in Need. The sessions are designed to support children's physical, social and emotional development through soft play and outdoor learning play activities, while also boosting parents' and carers' wellbeing by bringing people together.

Tuesday Social – every Tuesday Cherry Lodge becomes a warm and welcoming space for anyone to drop in, hang out, chat and enjoy a drink and a biscuit.

Chatty Cake Café – once a month we are joined by the volunteers from Church@Community to host two hours of friendly chat with free hot and cold drinks and cake and if you up for it a short, gentle stroll around King Edward Park.

Yoga – a weekly session of women only yoga.

Community Health Hubs – working with the local primary care network to provide a drop-in session for medication advice, blood pressure, height and weight checks as well as the opportunity to speak to wellbeing coaches and social prescribers.

Networks – three networks bringing together local organisations and groups to share be share and be connected to all the partners through regular network meetings and email communications. The networks are Children and Young People, Health and Wellbeing and Hardship.
